<p>Learning Strategy Focus (Comprehension strategy, literary elements etc.)</p>	<p>Retelling a story by sequence of events.</p>	
<p>Accountable Talk Questions Accountable to text? Accountable to others? Accountable to rigor?</p>	<p>Students keep track of characters in order: accountable to rigor and text</p>	
<p>Modeling In what ways will I demonstrate my own thinking as a reader?</p>	<p>When I read I keep track of what comes next in stories. This is called the sequence of events. I put the things that happen in the right order.</p>	
<p>Charting How will I collect student's ideas?</p>	<p>Good readers remember the order of things that happen in stories. List the characters in order (and their characteristics if you choose).</p>	
<p>Questioning What questions will I use to enhance the learning focus and deepen thinking?</p>	<p>Pre- Reading</p>	<p>Sometimes I like to retell a story because I like it. I keep track of the events in my mind so that I can tell the story later.</p>
	<p>During Reading</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Use the foreshadowing pictures to predict what character will be next. ● Collect the characters “on your fingers” and the describing words for each character as you read. ● Sample questions are: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Who is coming next and why? Tell your partner. 2. Tell your partner the next character and all the characters so far and their describing word. 3. The story went “up”. Now what might happen? Talk
<p>Closure / Send off How will I pull the lesson together at the end so that students know what they have learned? Connection back to the objective. Independent Assignment</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Review the chart sequence. ● Retell the whole story to your partner. Use your fingers to keep track of the characters if it will help you remember the sequence of events. ● Select a student to give a retell of the whole story ● Go home and tell a family member the whole story after school today.
