

Inter-District Transfer:

Students who were on an approved Inter-District transfer in 14-15 or previous years do not need to re-apply and will automatically be considered for the same school next year unless the student withdrew or transfer was revoked. This does not apply to students on a Continuation transfer.

The District reserves the right to determine and assign school placement within the district. Factors such as class size and enrollment, may be considered when determining school placement. Whenever possible, we try to send students to their school of choice.

It is the responsibility of the family to provide transportation for students on inter-district transfers.

Prior to the start of the school year, the Board will establish limits on the number of incoming and outgoing transfers that will be approved for the next school year. If the number of student seeking to transfer into the district exceeds the number of slots approved by the Board the district will conduct a fair and impartial lottery process. The process may give priority to students who have siblings currently enrolled in the district.

- Requests received before June 10th will be notified of the outcome by July 10th.
- Requests received between June 11th and August 25th will be reviewed and notification of approval or non-approval will be mailed out within three weeks of receipt.
- After August 25th petitioners will be notified within five days of receipt of the transfer.
