Important reminders for Parents, Participants and Chaperones:

- Students must ride the bus to/from Mt. Ashland unless being transported by their parent/guardian.
- Students should bring money for food or pack a lunch/dinner. A special combo lunch is available in the lodge for school groups.
- Participants need to bring/wear appropriate clothing. It can get very cold and windy. Having the right equipment will add to the enjoyment of this activity.
- Severe weather and/or road conditions can cause a trip to be cancelled by the school staff or Mt. Ashland personnel. Make-up trips and refunds will not be provided. Services are not transferable (ie. a sibling/friend takes the place of participant that gets ill etc.).
- Students cannot switch from snowboard to skiing or vice versa after the forms are submitted.
- Designated chaperones will be driving private vehicles to assist in transportation of equipment and for emergency purposes. *ski park permits are required. *If a participant becomes injured, parents may give permission for the student to be transported in a private vehicle. Major injuries will require ambulance transportation.
- Please be prompt for departure and arrival from CPE. It is best to arrive a few minutes early before our scheduled departure time of 3:45 p.m. We should arrive back to the school by 10:00 p.m. +/-.
- Students may never ski or board alone. Chaperones/Captains will assign buddy groups and take skill into consideration for grouping decisions.
- Chaperones/Captains will encourage students to communicate via cell phones regarding estimated time of arrival at the school.
- Please make sure your student's chaperone is aware of any special needs, concerns or conditions your student may have. We want this to be a great experience for all participants.
